The Dirision will, at the large stated time and places, receive written or oral comments and hear all view in favor of the opposed to the proposed issuance of the Bonds or the use of the proceeds of the hands, which will be issued to finance the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of the above-described Project located in the State for the benefit of the Borrower. A report of the hearing will be made to the Governor of Nevada, who will consider the issuance of the Bonds for approval for purposes of the Code.
