WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS

- Betsy expressed appreciation to everyone for their help.
- Introduction of new members: Steve Aichroth, Chief of Administration with the NHD; Jeni Chavez and Crystal Kleidosty from the Nevada Rural Housing Authority, *were not present*; Shelly Cochran, Deputy Director of the Nevada Apartment Association, *also not present*; Dwayne Alexander and assistant Laure Raposa from SNRHA; and Eric Willrich of Washoe County Social Services.

NEW NVHOUSINGSEARCH.ORG FEATURES

- There had not been a meeting recently, team was busy updating the system
- New features
 - New color, added NHD Logo, news, blog, veteran resources, and search engine optimization
 - Nevada is first in Housing Locator service (37 regions) with a blog, and some advisory members have already made contributions
 - Search engine optimization, has enhanced the number of people who can reach and use the site
 - New features that have been incorporated, are also new to Emphasis
 - We have 3 advisory board members involved with the blog, Silver State Fair Housing, Community Development Block Grant, and Ensemble Phase II
- Sheila walked through the site and gave a tour of the new features.
 - NHD control the content of news and blog feature
 - 9 different tiles can be showcased at once, all real time
 - All features get archived, never get lost

ALL ROADS LEAD HOME

- Nevada Vet Resource link is meant to be information that is community specific, consumer specific information and can be used by call center staff for referrals.
- Search engine optimization is very important, constantly refreshed content will push search result pages
- There was a suggestion that we might use an online survey tool of onsite visitors; this has been done in other states

PROGRAM STATUS UPDATE

Demonstrated a chart “Stats and Update Projections”

- Almost at 39,000 housing units listed
- Over 75 thousand individual searches in a 2 year period
- Past 2 months have had record searches, almost 5,000 searches a month
 - Summer is always best for searches vs. the holidays, people are not looking as much.

“Google Analytics” Chart

- 5,323 sessions over approximately the last month
 - Single session can be many searches
- Page views are at 28 thousand, about 5 pages per sessions
- Sessions are over 4½ min
- Almost 70% of the search sessions are new
- Lincoln County now has properties listed
- Mineral, Esmeralda and Storey is where we don’t have any listings
- Reviewed table displaying estimated % of total Multi-family units listed per region
 - Clark - 12%
 - Washoe - 24%
 - Carson - 22%
 - All others - 35%
 - NV approximate total is 14%
- Team satisfied with numbers, does not want upset any contenders
- Would like to have more opportunity to find available listings
- Not many single family homes are listed in the north, most are in the south. Would like more single family listings in Washoe County, NSP housing listed and works
- Landlord can list rooms, single-family rentals, duplexes, triplex, manufactured, etc.
- Might work with Manufactured Housing to reach out to mobile home parks

REPORTING ENHANCEMENTS

- Built out a detailed, granular search report
- Allows NHD to see what people are searching for
 - From features, to accessible features and if they are pulling results
 - Example; wide door, ramp entry, etc.
- Have activated back end identification numbers to help track and report on subsidized and affordable property tracking
 - Tax Credit Property
 - Will have AOD number assigned to them



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- Will help see all updates
 - HUD, USDA RD, PHA Properties
 - Details on properties added and updated in the system
 - It an easy way to track landlord participations
 - It's helps see where there is an opportunity for growth
- Housing locator has been used to encouraged growth in affordable housing in specific areas

HOW NVHOUSINGSEARCH.ORG CAN HELP PLACE HOUSEHOLDS IN THE PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM - KRISTIN COOPER

Kristin shared

- As a part of CCSS they have discovered gaps for serving the homeless
- Finding challenges in placing homeless in permanent supportive housing
- There doesn't seem to be a single place where nonprofits or Social Service could go to find inventory of permanent homes for the homeless (includes; disability, substance abuse, addictions)
 - People with no credit background, may not pass background checks, that come with case management and have rental assistance
 - Need one place to look for properties able to work with permanent supportive housing system and available units
- Need to find a place that is affordable and help landlords with the Social Service system
- Like to be able to find and track available units specifically for permanent supportive housing tenants
 - Most need studio or one bedroom units
- Might need a system specific to permanent supportive housing

Sheila shared

- The system is already set to help meet consumer and case worker needs
- The system allows case worker to find landlords that have indicated that they want to work with these agencies through the restricted access portal
- Had to build up inventory before using portal. Money Follows the Person is currently using the system.
- In the registration process, landlords are asked if they want to work with these agencies and also can opt out on requesting consumers background and credit check
- An approved case worker, who has registered through NHD receives access and can search for units for their consumers
- System also notifies case worker when a unit is available
- Due to confidentiality, the general public can't search but veterans are an exceptions
- NVHousingSearch could help in raising awareness to the landlords, flyers can be sent to let them know there is a need for supportive services, to see if they could make rental properties available
- Want to make sure that there is inventory to help the case workers, want to understand the consumers and the service area needs
- Can look into sending an e-blast to landlords to try to recruit more interest amongst landlords



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- Reach out to Betsy to help get anyone started with restricted access portal
- Fair Housing principals apply to disabled, people eligible for PSH – education needed

PROMOTIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

- Looking on how to raise awareness, always looking for feasible way to promote the program
- Have participated in various trade shows, KOLO TV, NVSAA, Nevada Real-estate radio, Family health fair (ongoing), VA Lunch, Alliance for Nevada, Nevada Public Housing Authority webinars, e-blast to property owners, and online publications
- Facebook post work well in getting additional searches over the weekends
- New buttons are out, please link to NVHS on your website. Some already have links in place – please update links with new buttons if possible.
