The purpose of the hearing is to consider the issuance of up to \$22,000,000 in multi-unit housing revenue bonds or notes of the Division (the "Bonds") pursuant to a plan of finance, for the acquisition and renovation costs of the following residential multifamily housing rental project located in Clark County: (i) Baltimore Gardens Apartments at 301, 304, 305, 308, 309, 312, 313, 316, 317, 321 W. Baltimore Avenue and 2112, 2116, 2200, 2204, 2208 Tam Drive, Las Vegas, Nevada, consisting of 165 units and (ii) Cleveland Gardens Apartments at 311, 313, 315, 317, 319, 321 W. Cleveland Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada, consisting of 36 units (the "Project"). The Project will be owned by BGCG LP, a Nevada limited partnership and will be operated by Cornerstone Residential, LLC.

THE BONDS WILL BE AN OBLIGATION OF THE DIVISION, PAYABLE FROM THE ASSETS OR REVENUES PLEDGED THEREFOR. IN NO EVENT SHALL THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF (OTHER THAN THE DIVISION) BE LIABLE ON THE BONDS, AND THE BONDS SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE A DEBT OF THE STATE OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF WITHIN THE MEANING OF ANY CONSTITUTIONAL OR STATUTORY LIMITATION. THE DIVISION HAS NO TAXING POWER.

The Division will, at the above stated time and place, receive written or oral comments and hear all views in favor of or opposed to the proposed issuance of the Bonds or the use of the proceeds of the Bonds, which will be issued to finance the acquisition and renovation of the above-described project located in the State. A report of the hearing will be made to the Governor of Nevada, who will consider the issuance of the Bonds for approval for purposes of the Code.
