

### Supportive Housing, Group Homes and Skilled Nursing Facilities in Nevada

The Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public and Behavioral Health Division issues licenses for various types of health facilities. A subset of these licensed facilities provide beds for residential treatment, supportive housing or group homes. The tables below give information about this subset of health facilities, and the number of beds and low-income beds available for each Nevada county and type of licensed health facility. **Changes since 2019 report**

As compared to last year’s report, and collapsing the two categories of Community Based Living Arrangement Services from last year, there were a total of 395 additional beds reported in 2020. About half of those, 184 beds, were in Clark County. These were mostly accounted for by 133 new beds in skilled nursing facilities and 104 new beds in psychiatric residential treatment facilities. Other notable changes were the loss of 52 intermediate care beds in Clark County, the addition of 80 skilled nursing beds in Carson City and additional 57 beds for psychiatric residential treatment facilities in Washoe County.

For the past two years there has been a drop in beds set aside for low income individuals. Last year 230 beds in residential facilities for groups were set aside for low income individuals. This July the number has dropped to 215. In 2018, a total of 169 beds in Residential Facilities for Groups were set aside for low income individuals in Clark County while in Washoe County there were 115 beds set aside.

Not included in the totals in Table 1 are swing beds that can serve as either acute care or skilled nursing beds. According to the *Nevada Rural and Frontier Health Data Book, Ninth Edition* there were an additional 117 swing beds licensed in rural and frontier Nevada in 2018.
