

Supportive Housing, Group Homes and Skilled Nursing Facilities in Nevada

The Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public and Behavioral Health Division issues licenses for various types of health facilities. A subset of these licensed facilities provide beds for residential treatment, supportive housing or group homes. The tables below give information about this subset of health facilities, and the number of beds and low income beds available for each Nevada county and type of licensed health facility. Changes since 2018 report

As compared to last year's report, and disregarding the two new categories of Community Based Living Arrangement Services and the Skilled Nursing Facility as Distinct Part of Hospital category since those were not included last year, there were a total of 1,249 additional beds reported in 2019. Most of those, 1,155 beds, were in Clark County. These were mostly accounted for by 272 new intermediate care beds and 651 new beds in residential facilities for groups.

As compared to last year there was a drop in beds set aside for low income individuals. Last year a total of 169 beds in Residential Facilities for Groups were set aside for low income individuals in Clark County while in Washoe County there were 115 beds set aside.

Not included in the totals in Table 1 are swing beds that can serve as either acute care or skilled nursing beds. According to the *Nevada Rural and Frontier Health Data Book, Ninth Edition* there were an additional 117 swing beds licensed in rural and frontier Nevada in 2018. See Table 6.2.
