To Provide Information about the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Funding FFY 2024-2025

Emergency Solutions Grant Service Provider and Local Government applications will be available beginning Monday, March 11, 2024. ESG applications will be open for 60 days and close at 5 p.m. on Friday, May 10, 2024. The ESG program is designed to identify sheltered and unsheltered homeless persons, as well as those at risk of homelessness, and provide the services necessary to help those persons quickly maintain or regain stability in permanent housing after experiencing a housing crisis and/or homelessness.

The Division may take items out of order, combine two or more agenda items at any time, or remove agenda items. Reasonable efforts will be made to assist and accommodate physically handicapped persons desiring to attend the hearing.
