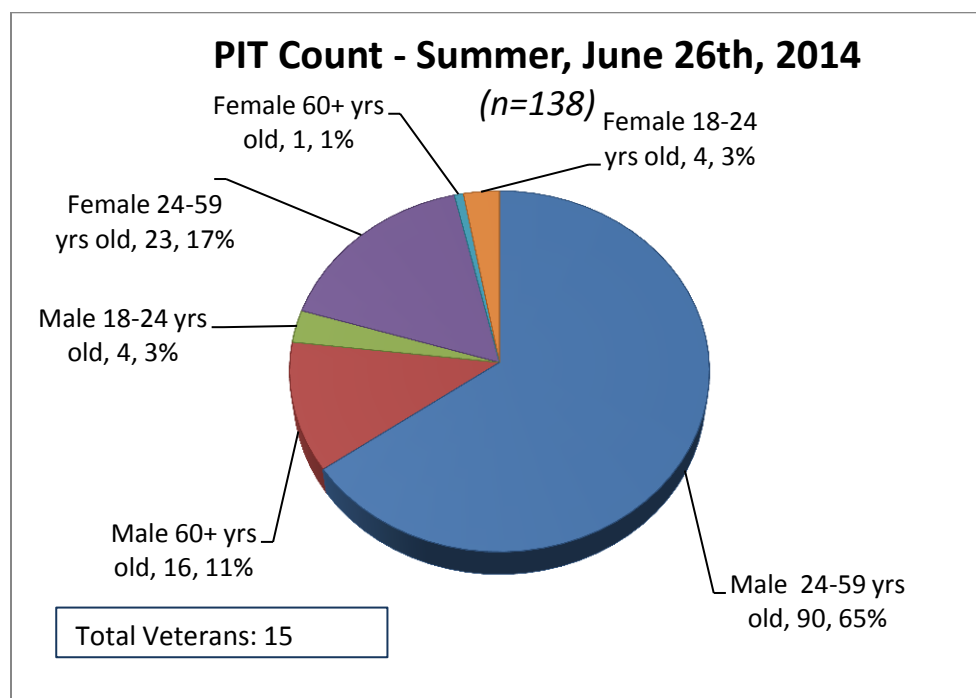


RAAH Summer PIT Count Report

June 26, 2014

The Summer PIT Count was conducted on June 26, 2014. Volunteers from law enforcement, Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada, the City of Reno, the University of Nevada, Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation, Northern Nevada Hopes, the Veterans Administration, Volunteers of America, Washoe County School District, Washoe County Social Services, and WestCare, met at 4 a.m. at 350 S. Center Street to get assigned locations and later dispersed in 15 separate teams. Kids to Seniors Korner provided services from their van, and volunteers passed out bags of sunscreen, Neosporin, hand wipes and snickers bars to individuals being counted.

The graph below shows the exact breakout of those counted, but in summary there were 110 males and 28 females for a total of 138. Of those 138 individuals, 15 were veterans.



On the evening of June 25th, Volunteers of America conducted a count of their emergency shelters and provided the following information:

Of the 348, 259 were male, 88 were female, and 1 was transgender. Of the 348, 50 were veterans.
