NEVADA HOUSING DIVISION MINORITY/WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES OUTREACH (MBE/WBE)

It is the Nevada Housing Division's policy that minority and women's business enterprises be afforded the chance to fully participate in all business opportunities resulting from programs administered by the Division. All beneficiaries of HOME and Low Income Housing Trust funded programs are directed to implement measures that perform MBE/WBE outreach activity, and encourage minority and women's business to apply for a share of HOME/LIHTF sponsored or generated industry. State recipients must:

- A. Maintain a system for identifying and profiling (goods, services, products, etc.) MBE/WBEs and their capabilities.
 - 1. Maintain a master list of MBE/WBEs or specify in your procedures the method used to contact MBE/WBEs when offering a business opportunity for contract.
 - 2. The Division, in cooperation with the Commission of Economic Development, Small Business Office, is making available information on minority and women owned firms.
- B. In addition to other forms of advertising business opportunities, use public service announcements (PSAs) in radio/television advertising and public notices in the newspapers.
 - 1. Maintain records of promotional efforts; if PSAs and/or public notices cannot be utilized, note the reason.
 - 2. Efforts in this area should be documented in order to develop reports that measure the effectiveness of the program.
- C. In cooperation with the Division, develop materials and methods for distribution of these materials that promote MBE/WBE. These materials shall provide notice and information of HOME/LIHTF sponsored activity in contracting for goods or services. Information should include impending deadlines, methods for application, where additional information and assistance may be obtained.
- D. Comply with procurement procedures established to facilitate opportunities for MBE/WBE. The Division is working with the State of Nevada Commission on Economic Development-Small Business Office, the State of Nevada Commission on Economic Development- Procurement Outreach Program, and the Minority Business Recruiter of Clark County to develop a responsive and effective program to encourage MBE/WBE participation in HOME/LIHTF activities. The Division has procured updated directories of MBE/WBE for the state, and an additional directory for Clark County and has arranged for jurisdictions to utilize the resources of the Small Business Office as a standard operating procedure in procurement matters connected with HOME/LIHTF activities. The Small Business Office will utilize its database to provide

- jurisdictions with MBE/WBE contacts in order to enhance solicitation effectiveness and further MBE/WBE outreach efforts.
- E. Assist in the production of conferences and meetings designed to promote MBE/WBE. The Division will sponsor, attend, and support developmental seminars and informational conferences with the purpose of making MBE/WBEs aware of the business opportunities connected with the HOME/LIHTF Program. Through local governments the Division will meet with minority and women's businesses to discuss their roles in helping to provide affordable housing while increasing their participation in HOME/LIHTF-funded activities. State recipients will be required to assist in the sponsorship of MBE/WBE meetings and conferences by using their local contacts to invite participation and utilization of the conference/seminar format.
- F. Submit reports as outlined in the Written Agreement. The Agreement will require reports that provide statistical data on the participation of MBE/WBE in HOME/LIHTF-assisted programs. Records shall be kept detailing outreach efforts and responses.
